




- A. When the device is OFF, short press Zone 1 to power on device.
- B. When power is ON, short press Zone 1 button to toggle volume ON/OFF, press and hold Zone 1 to power OFF.
- C. When power is ON, short press Zone 2 button to toggle volume ON/OFF, press and hold Zone 2 to power OFF.
- D. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash if there is no device connected, a solid light indicates a device is now connected.
- E. To pair to a different device, you can press and hold ZONE 2 button for 2 seconds to clear the connection and pair again.

Application Setup



- Download the DRIVEN app from the App Store or Google Play.
- 2 Make sure that the DRBTM2 is connected and powered on.
- 3 Check your device's settings. Make sure Bluetooth® is ON.
- 4 Launch the app on your device.



5 Open the Scan & Pair menu.




6 Select the DRIVEN BT to pair the device.
